# Open Division Class Descriptions

Classes in the Open Division focus on dance instruction for the mature student—ages 14 and up. Students may attend as often as they like and can place themselves in the level they find most comfortable. Enrollment is open throughout the school year. Dress code is casual dance attire and appropriate footwear.

## NEW! Ballet 101

If you've always wanted to take a ballet class, but were afraid to try, Ballet 101 is for you! This free one hour workshop is designed for adults interested in exploring the fundamentals of ballet in a fun, relaxed setting. You will be introduced to the format of a ballet class and learn to execute basic positions and steps. Ballet 101 is for both dancers and dance lovers, anyone who is interested in gaining a greater understanding of the art of classical ballet. Workshop meets the first Monday of the month from 5:30-6:30 pm in Studio 3. Pre-registration not required; workout attire recommended.

Tuition: **FREE!**

2011-2012 Ballet 101 dates: Oct. 3, Nov. 7, Dec. 5, Feb. 6, Mar. 5, and May 7. (No class on Sept 5, Jan. 2, or Apr. 2.)

## Beginning Ballet

Students are introduced to the terminology and steps of classical ballet. Emphasis is placed on alignment and injury prevention during barre work; perfect for anyone who wishes to increase their flexibility, musicality, and overall strength. Basic combinations and traveling patterns are explored in floor exercises customized for the ability of each class. This class is appropriate for those who have never danced or those with previous experience who would like to start slowly.

## Intermediate Ballet

Dancers with a medium to advanced understanding of vocabulary continue to study ballet technique. Barre routines remain simple, but floor combinations increase in complexity and particular attention is given to phrasing. Floor exercises are customized to the skill level of each class at the teacher's discretion.

## Advanced Ballet

Dancers with a high comprehension of ballet technique and vocabulary continue to study ballet technique. Floor combinations continue to increase in complexity beyond that of the Intermediate Level.

## Pilates & Core Conditioning

Using the basic mat exercises developed by Joseph Pilates, along with additional stretching and strengthening techniques, students will develop an awareness of the power of their core abdominal muscles. Discover how use of your center can increase balance, overall fitness, and prevent injuries.
